St Agatha's Catholic Primary School's admission criteria

- 1. Looked after Catholic children or looked after children in the care of Catholic families and previously looked after Catholic children who have been adopted
- 2 Baptised Catholic children and children enrolled in the catechumenate
- 3 Other looked after children or looked after children in the care of families and previously looked after children who have been adopted
- 4. Children of families who are members of other Christian denominations
- 5. Children of other faiths
- 6. Any other children

If oversubscribed in any category, the following criteria will be applied in order: i) sibling at the time of admission, ii) in categories 1 and 2 the strength of evidence of commitment to the faith by the level of family's mass attendance on Sundays, iii) in category 4 the strength of evidence of commitment to the faith by the level of family's church attendance on Sundays, iv) exceptional social, medical or pastoral need which makes the school the most suitable, v) the distance from the child's home measured by a straight line to the school gate.
