Birthday Treats

Although there is absolutely no expectation that parents provide birthday treats for their child's class, we know that some parents like to do this and we respect their wishes. If this is the case, we ask that any treats are small, nut-free, individually wrapped, shop bought (not home-made) and are inexpensive.

Attendance

This week, parents will see the return of the attendance league table which will be emailed out every Tuesday from now on. The much-coveted attendance trophy will then be awarded to the class with the highest attendance.

By way of a reminder, the school's attendance target is set at 96.9% and it is one of our priorities to reach or even surpass this level throughout the school year.

Lost Property & School Uniform

We do not have the storage space nor the staff in the office to manage and store large amounts of non-labelled lost property.

When clearly labelled items are brought to the office, these will be returned to their owners within 24 hours. Non-labelled items will be kept for a short time at the office, and then disposed of or donated to the PSA.

If you have purchased new uniform, can we kindly ask you to note these points:

- All items should be properly labelled with your child's 1st and 2nd names.
- Please use a permanent marker or iron/sew on labels. Standard pens quickly wash out and markings become unclear and illegible.
- ALL items including lunchboxes, water bottles etc should be labelled.
- Non-uniform items, eg coats/hats/MUFTI clothing should also be clearly labelled.

Home-Start Volunteers
