Nut Free Zone

Please be reminded that St Agatha's School is a completely nut-free zone. Under no circumstances should any packed lunches or snacks be brought into school which contain nuts of any kind. This includes snacks eaten in the playground at pick up time.

Mid-morning Snack: Children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are provided with a piece of fruit each day, as part of the government School Fruit & Vegetable Scheme.

Children in KS2 should bring an appropriate snack to eat during their morning breaktime.

Parent Teacher Consultations

School closes at 12pm for Reception-Year 6 on Thursday 19th October for the Autumn Parent Teacher Consultations. These meetings will be held for Nursery to Year 6, <u>virtually</u> via Teams between 1pm - 7pm. Appointments should be booked via our PTC booking system.

The booking system will go live **from 11am on the 6**th **October and will close at 9am on the 16**th **October**. Parents will receive a link to book, via email, when the system is live. Secondary School Transfer 2024

Children born between 1st September 2012 and 31st August 2013 are due to start Year 7 at secondary school in September 2024. The closing date for applications is **31st October 2023**. If you do not live in the borough, you need to apply through your own council and you can include Kingston schools in your application.
