This is a fantastic achievement and I would like to thank the staff and pupils for all their hard work over the past 5 years that have contributed to this. The result is also a very positive reflection of the welcoming and strong community spirit of our school. Thank you for all that you contribute to this ethos.

The Denominational Inspection is something which all Church schools must have and follows similar lines to an Ofsted inspection, with a focus on the religious aspects of school life. The inspectors looked at everything to do with the Catholic character of the school, including leadership, religious education, worship, moral and spiritual development, and links with the local Catholic community.
